Murwillumbah to Mt Warning Rd	11km	14 mins
Mt Warning Rd to Uki	5km	8 mins
Uki to Tyalgum (via Byrill Creek)	30km	60 mins
Tyalgum to Chillingham	12km	15 mins
Chillingham to Murwillumbah	16km	18 mins
Total Travel	74km	115mins

Driving Tips

The scenic route from Uki to Tyalgum via Byrill Creek includes 10+kms of unsealed road. While it is suitable for most 2WDs, you may prefer the alternative sealed road: From Uki, drive back towards Murwillumbah for 9km and turn left onto Tyalgum Road.

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Murwillumbah is home to a number of providers who use local produce in their cafes and restaurants. Stroll the main street to take your pick of café and restaurants.

On your way to Wollumbin Mount Warning stock up on fresh produce at the Guinea Farm Stall and stop for lunch at Mavis's Kitchen or the Rainforest Café. Visit the charming shops and cafes at Uki.

Continue around the Caldera for a scenic rainforest drive via Byrill Creek Road (partly unsealed) or head back towards Murwillumbah for the alternative turn off to Tyalgum (sealed) where you can enjoy afternoon tea at Flutterbies Café. Experience a hands on farm tour at Chillingham Bush Tucker before heading to Tumbulgum Tavern to watch the sunset over the river.
